LIBRARY MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM

In order to expand our community's access and exposure to the Hudson Highlands Nature Museum, we offer special memberships that libraries can purchase to lend out to their patrons. *Libraries are responsible for setting lending policies and managing membership cards.*

A year-long, \$100 library membership includes:
